



# Installation of NSU Kiosk App for Chromebooks

Master teachers will not require Respondus Lockdown Browser for quizzes/tests if they know the school/student is using a managed Chromebook(s). This also pertains to dual credit students enrolled in university classes. Instead, the e-mentor will need to put the Chromebook(s) into kiosk mode. This is done with an app called "NSU Kiosk App". Please follow these instructions to install the NSU Kiosk app for all managed Chromebooks.

## Force install apps

These steps assume you're familiar with making Chrome settings in your Admin console.

1. Sign in to your [Google Admin console](#).
2. Sign in using an administrator account, not your current account
3. From the Admin console Home page, go to Devices and then Chrome.
4. Click Apps & Extensions and then Users & Browsers or Managed guest sessions.
5. To apply the setting to all users and enrolled browsers, leave the top organizational unit selected. Otherwise, select a child organizational unit.
6. Go to the app that you want to automatically install.
7. Under Installation policy, choose Force install or Force install + pin.
8. Click Save. If you configured a child organizational unit, you might be able to Inherit or Override a parent organizational unit's settings.
